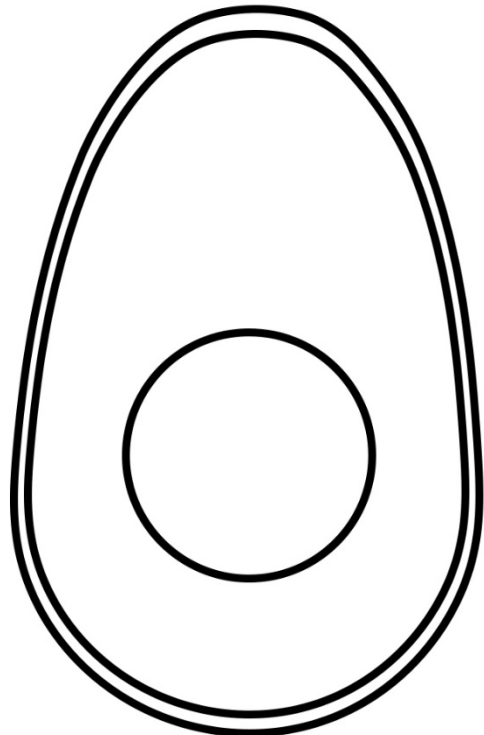
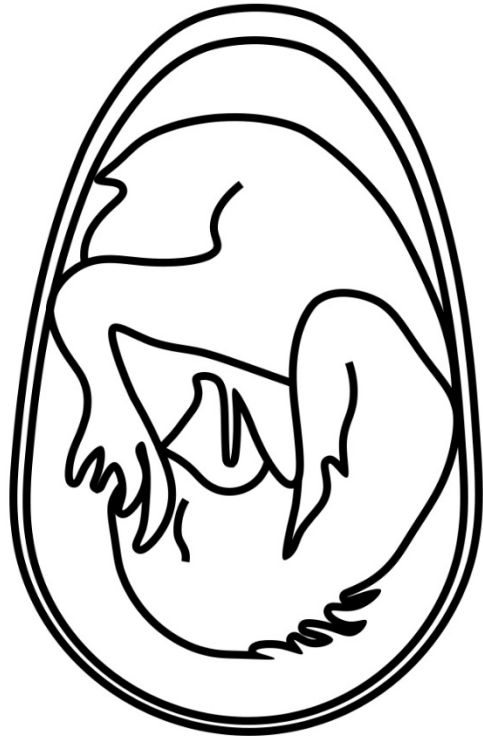
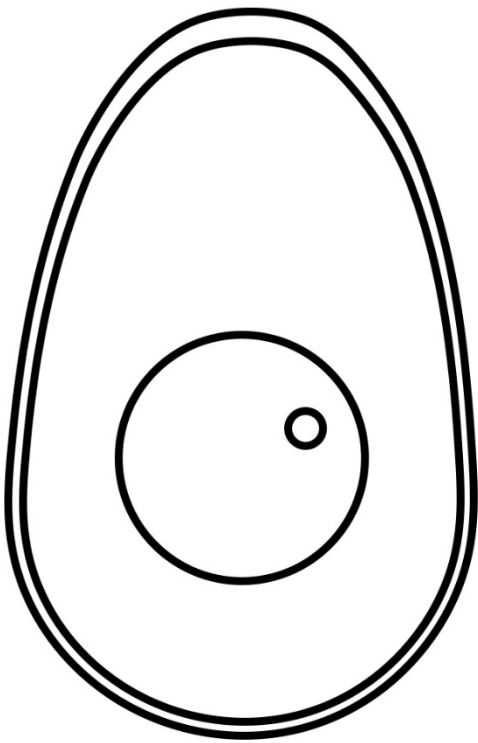
Draw some of the stages of a
